#### Introduction

We had 12 online meetings. The rest of the year communication among the members of the PC was done by email.

#### **Key issues & activities**

The work of the Committee focused on the following areas. Briefly:

- 1. 5-year plan: On 9th February 2023, the Committee organised and hosted the first in a series of talks exploring the politics of knowledge and its dissemination. The event titled "What does the Open Science Movement mean for the future of the field of media and communication?" featured two speakers: Prof Lucy Montgomery, Professor of Knowledge Innovation, Curtin University, Australia; and Dr. Tiffany Straza, consultant on open science at the Section of Science Technology and Innovation Policy, Natural Sciences Sector, UNESCO.
  We plan to do more on this topic.
- 2. 2023 conference in Lyon: The Committe has organised a roundtable discussion on Open Access, and is co-sponsoring 4 more PubComm-related events.
- 3. Possibility of IAMCR journal: We are making progress on this following the support of the idea by the IC.
